Youth Emergency Services Receives Changemaker Grant

The second annual Women's Fund of Omaha Changemaker grant was presented to [Youth Emergency Services](#) at the Aug. 25 Omaha Fashion Week runway show. This \$5,000 award was decided by a vote of Women's Fund Changemakers – donors who supported our work with a financial contribution of \$200 or more this year.

Youth Emergency Services serves homeless and at-risk youth by providing critically needed resources, which empower them to become self-sufficient. The Changemaker grant provides funding for young women in the agency's Transitional Living Program and Maternity Group Home to participate in financial literacy and employment training programs that include a matched savings account.
