#### Collaboration

By utilizing current research, we identify change where it is needed most in our community.

This includes providing updates to previous research and staying current with trends impacting gender equity. We have collaborated with local experts to develop an employee toolkit on domestic/sexual violence and the workplace, developed a media resource to change the narrative on gender-based violence, reported on the state of domestic violence in Douglas County, and regularly review and use research around other critical issues that impact economic security.

### **GRANT MAKING**

We provide grants exclusively to programs addressing gender-based inequities.

Grant Making in 2025: With a commitment to supporting barrier-free access to sexual and reproductive health care, the Women's Fund invested nearly \$1 million to provide free STI testing and treatment, and free condoms throughout the community. We also worked to remove barriers to emergency contraception by launching sexual health vending machines. Our focus continues to be on improving and increasing access to the sexual and reproductive health care that all young people in Nebraska and Southwest lowa need.



The Women's Fund invested more than \$1 million in agencies and community partners for training, protocol development and survivor leadership to create a community where everyone can live free from gender-based violence.

Since our work began in 1990, the Women's Fund has invested more than \$61 MILLION in our community to improve the lives of those who experience gender-based oppression.



## **ADVOCACY**

Our work is propelled forward through our policy efforts.

We are committed to leading dynamic change by advocating for effective public policy solutions that addresses gender-based inequities in Nebraska. We are focused on legislation that aligns with our values of equity, bold impact, collaboration, community voice, intersectionality, bodily autonomy and rest.
