# Submit Online Comments

The Legislature has added a new way for you to share your position on bills this year—online comments! Your engagement in this way continues to be a critical part of the process. Join us by using your voice to advocate for the issues important to you. From the comfort of your own home and in less than five minutes, you can submit an online comment and be part of the legislative process!

## Six Easy Steps to Leave a Comment

1. Go to <https://www.NebraskaLegislature.gov>
2. Find the bill you care about in the upper righthand corner.
3. Click “Submit Comments Online.”

4. Enter your info as a Proponent (if you support the bill) and Opponent (if you are against).
5. Share your message in just a few short sentences!

6. After submitting, confirm your comment via the email you provided.
